Parent Advisory Committee

We're thinking about making a few gentle adjustments to some managerial type procedures at GVES for the 2017-18 school year. I'm interested in forming a parent advisory committee that would be willing to meet with me and the school leadership team a couple of times throughout the summer as we evaluate potential changes. Changes to Afternoon Pick-Up

We are exploring the potential of eliminating the walk-up portion of the afternoon pick-up process. Over the past few years, several positions at GVES have been eliminated. This reduction in staffing makes it difficult, if not impossible, to safely manage multiple areas of child pick-up in the afternoon. Currently, we are thinking about running the car-rider line through the doors that have traditionally been walk-up. We will likely plan to have the car rider lines continue to loop around the gravel road. Car-rider typically starts at 3:05 and ends by 3:20, at the latest. We don't anticipate this creating any significant issues and will help us run a safer, more controlled release process.

Changes to Morning Drop-Off

We are currently evaluating potential changes to the morning drop-off routine. We're working hard to ensure we close any potential loopholes in our crisis and security plan. Particularly, there is a possibility that we will ask parents to no longer walk children to their classroom in the morning after the 2nd week of school. Having parents drop kids off at the front main door, as opposed to entering the building and walking to the classroom, helps us maintain a controlled and secure situation in the morning time
